National Digital Literacy Mission (NDLM)

The Digital Saksharta Abhiyan (DISHA) or National Digital Literacy Mission (NDLM) Scheme has been formulated to impart IT training to 52.5 lakhs persons across the country so that the non -IT literate citizens are trained to become IT literate. This scheme is implementing under Department of electronics & Information technology, Ministry of communication & information technology, govt. of India.

Course - Appreciation of Digital Literacy (Level 1):

To make a person IT literate, so that he/ she can operate digital devices, like mobile phones, tablets, etc., send and receive emails and search Internet for information, etc.

Eligibility Criteria: Non - IT literate - Illiterate and 7th standard pass

Age: 14 to 60 years

Course Duration: 20 Hours (Minimum 10 Days)

Medium of Instruction: Official Languages of India (Hindi/English)

Fee: No training fee payable

Assessment (Exam):

After the completion of training, the assessment will be done by NIELIT through an online exam. Questions for the assessment would be based on the modules covered under Level 1. Total 25 questions (Objective and True or False questions) will be asked during the examination. After clearing the online assessment, candidates will be certified by NIELIT & Training Center will get their share from NDLM TP.

Commercial / Payment:

- Rs. 350 for SC/ST and BPL category trainees from NDLM TP
- Rs. 262.50 for General category trainees from NDLM TP
- Payment only for Passed & Certified Candidates
- All payments would be according to NDLM Guidelines only

Process:

- Online Registration of student Aadhar (UIDAI No.) & Caste/Category certificate (SC, ST, OBC, BPL) compulsory to be uploaded with Student entry.
- Training of 20 Hours
- After completing the training conduct the online exam
- Result, Certification & Payment

ACCREDITATION NORMS FOR TRAINING CENTRES

The Training Partner shall appoint the Training Centers in the District/Block/Panchayat/Village.
