

## National Digital Literacy Mission (NDLM)

**The Digital Saksharta Abhiyan (DISHA) or National Digital Literacy Mission (NDLM)** Scheme has been formulated to impart IT training to 52.5 lakhs persons across the country so that the non -IT literate citizens are trained to become IT literate. This scheme is implementing under Department of electronics & Information technology, Ministry of communication & information technology, govt. of India.

### Two levels of training under the SCHEME:

#### Appreciation of Digital Literacy (Level 1)

To make a person IT literate, so that he/ she can operate digital devices, like mobile phones, tablets, etc., send and receive emails and search Internet for information, etc.

#### Basics of Digital Literacy (Level 2)

Besides IT literacy at a higher level, the citizen would also be trained to effectively access the various e-Governance services being offered to the citizen by the Government and other agencies.

#### Eligibility Criteria

**Level 1 :** Non-IT literate - Illiterate and up to 7th standard pass

**Level 2 :** Non-IT literate with at least 8th standard pass

**Age :** 14 to 60 years

#### Course Duration

**Level 1 :** 20 Hours (Minimum 10 Days and Maximum 30 Days)

**Level 2 :** 40 Hours (Minimum 20 Days and Maximum 60 Days)

**Medium of Instruction: Level 1 and 2 :** Official Languages of India

#### Place of Learning

The eligible households can nominate one person from their family. The selected person to get himself enrolled under this programme in a nearest Training Centre/ Common Service Center (CSC).

#### Evaluation

Independent external evaluation will be conducted by a National level certifying agency like NIELIT, NIOS, IGNOU, etc.

### Who can be a Training Partner?

- A training partner must be an organization registered in India, conducting business in the domain of education/ IT literacy for more than three years and having Permanent Income Tax Account Number (PAN) and audited accounts of statements for at least last three years.
- The institution/ organisation should be registered under any act of law in India.
- The partner must have clearly defined objectives, well-documented processes and procedures covering the entire range of education /IT literacy training.

### Role of a Training Partner

- A training partner shall be responsible to have or appoint the Training Centers in the identified Districts/ Blocks/ Gram Panchayats that would impart digital literacy training to the beneficiaries.
- A training partner shall be responsible for ensuring that the training centers adhere to the NDLM requirements.
- A training partner shall be accountable for monitoring the overall working of the centers that fall under its purview.
- A training partner shall be liable for accurate and timely reporting of the aforementioned work ascribed to the centers.

### Commercial/Payment to Training Partner from Deity:

#### Level 1:

Rs. 500 for SC/ ST and BPL category trainees.

Rs. 375 for General category trainees.

Payment will be made only for candidates who pass the examination.

#### Level 2:

Rs. 1000 for SC/ ST and BPL category trainees.

Rs. 750 for General category trainees.

Payment will be made only for candidates who pass the examination.
