Notice INVITING PROPOSALS FOR EMPANELMENT DURING 2015-16

1. Ministry of minority Affairs invites proposals in the prescribed format from eligible Project Implementing Agencies (PIAs) under the scheme of “Seekho aur Kamao”, the Skill Development Initiative for Minorities during the year 2015-16.
2. The PIAs who were empanelled by the Ministry since 2013-14, **need not apply afresh.**
3. PIAs shall send the proposals by post or submit in person to Under Secretary (RML), 11th Floor, Paryavaran Bhawan, CGO Complex, Lodhi Road, New Delhi – 110003.
4. The last date for submission of proposal to the Ministry is 16th November, 2015 (Monday) till 5:00 p.m. One PIA shall submit only one proposal.
5. The proposal will be examined by the Ministry on a point based system for mandatory criteria. The organization securing minimum 70(seventy) points out of 100, will fall in zone of consideration. Point based system for mandatory criteria, scheme guidelines, terms and conditions and other relevant information are available on the Ministry’s website www.minorityaffairs.gov.in. The organizations which fall in zone of consideration may be called for a presentation before a Committee of the Ministry.
6. The list of shortlisted / rejected KPs will be posted on the Ministry’s website. The decision of the Ministry in this regard shall be final and binding on the organizations.
7. This Ministry shall not be responsible for any loss of proposals and postal delays. Such cases will be deemed rejected. Proposals will not be received through Courier.
8. Ministry of Minority Affairs reserves the right, without any obligation or liability, to accept or reject any or all of the proposals at any stage of the process, to cancel or modify the process or any part thereof, or to vary any of the terms and conditions at any time, without assigning any reasons thereof.
